Activity 1

Title: Technological development of the IRIS WP interface (Dspace) for the end users

WHO CC HILS continued to monitor the updating documents and the IT issues of the IRIS.

Activity 2

Title: assist in the scanning and cataloguing into IRIS of WHO's published material and technical information kept in Country Offices and in Regional Office

Description: In coordination with Regional Office Library, assist in the scanning and cataloguing into IRIS of WHO's published material and technical information kept in Country Offices and in Regional Office

WHO CC HILS reported the strategy of WHO electronic documents on WHO WPRO web site; those documents are not available on IRIS. There are total 185 PDFs links on web pages of the Health topics (<http://www.wpro.who.int/topics/en/>), and the web pages of Programmes and projects (<http://www.wpro.who.int/entity/en/>) have around 773 pdfs on 357 web pages.

Activity 3

Title: Internal Survey (needs assessment) in the Country Offices

Description: Internal survey (needs assessment) in country offices to analyze their needs in term of resources, information/library tools and infrastructure.

We finished the internal survey and analyzed the result of survey.

Activity 4

Title: Trainings on basic library services for non-librarians (administrative staff) working for WHO in the WR and CLOs offices based on needs assessment

Description: Assist Regional Office Library in promoting and organizing training and workshop based on needs assessment

Delivered the proposal of 'library clinic' service targeting internal WPRO staffs.

Activity 5

Title: Creation and maintenance of a dedicated website for external researchers

Description: Creation and maintenance of a dedicated website for external researchers (portal, compilation and description of the materials available in WPRO) with online registration and inquiries for accessing WHO material.

WHO CC HILS finished to update WPRO library web page, and we continued monitoring.

Activity 6

Title: Document delivery service

Description: Document delivery service to WHO staff (WP and Countries) and researchers to access full text articles on databases not subscribed under GIFT and not available in PubMed.

SNU Medical library delivered full text articles requested from WPRO library. Total 28 articles delivered through Korea Medlars Center at SNU Medical library in 2017.

Activity 7

Title: Continued support to the development of the journal article database in coordination with KAMJE and IMICAMS.

Description: To assist in the continuing development of the journal article database in coordination with KAMJE and IMICAMS.

Professor Jeong-wook Seo continued to coordinate the Korean journal articles DB and WPRIM(Western Pacific Region Index Medicus)
